


Clun Castle

Managed by English Heritage (free to enter) the Norman Clun Castle used to play a key role in protecting the



area from Welsh invasion. Later owned by the Fitzalan family the castle eventually fell out of use and was partly ruined in the English Civil War.

This route has been designed to complement O/S Explorer map No. 201

- Directions**
- Key TL = Turn Left, TR = Turn Right
- 1 Park in the Castle Car Park at **SY7 8JT**. TL and walk towards the Clun bridge and then TL up over the bridge and follow Bridge St to the right uphill. At the junction TR on to High St, continue ahead and then TR opposite Powell's Ln on a small footpath that leads down and around to the left eventually in a narrow alleyway and then down a driveway to the ford and the bridge over the river Clun.
 - 2 Continue ahead uphill until you see the stile/footbridge on the left over a stream. Cross this and head on the path up the field to the following stile onto a narrow lane leading uphill. **Occasional cattle grazed in this field - detour around on lanes if required.** TL onto the narrow lane and continue up past Woodhill Farm and down to a junction on the corner. **Please be careful on this road.**
 - 3 TL at the corner junction and follow the lower (signed Pooh Hall) track around. At a following split in tracks TR up to Pooh Hall. Continue past the Hall and then through a gate. Continue uphill into the woods until you reach a 'T' junction. TR here uphill until you see a track on the left, TL here and continue upwards. **Be careful of steep ascents here.**
 - 4 Continue on rough track to a track cross roads, continue ahead and up here until it reaches cleared woodland on the left and eventually the radio mast. TR at the mast, through the gate and downhill to a track/byway 'T' junction. **For extra loop users TL here at this junction.**
 - 5 TR at 'T' junction and follow track first uphill and then down to a minor cross roads.
 - 6 TR on to minor road at cross roads. Follow this road as it snakes around and then downhill eventually to previous road/track junction. **Please be careful on this road..** Follow road around to the left and uphill and then back down to the stile on your right and your track down across the field to the ford. Retrace your route up the alleyway, out on to Main St and then left back down the the Clun Bridge and your start point.
- Info:** For post walk refreshments consider the Bridge Coffee Shop or The White Horse or Sun pubs.
